

Terms and Conditions

1. The Oxford Brookes Santander Scholarship will only be awarded to students enrolled in the first year of study, who meet the eligibility criteria.
2. Students must meet all of the following in order to be eligible for the scholarship:
 - 2.1. Be studying in the first year of a full-time 3 or 4-year undergraduate degrees or integrated foundation year.
 - 2.2. Be a Home fee paying student, paying the maximum fee of £9,250.
 - 2.3. Have made an online application to Student Finance England (SFE) and be eligible for an offer of funding (the offer does not need to be accepted but the applicant must have consented to share their information with Brookes when applying to SFE and must provide SFE with their bank account details).
 - 2.4. Be in receipt of an Oxford Brookes bursary
3. Students must also meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - 3.1. Be a mature student (age 21 or over at enrolment)
 - 3.2. Have previously lived in local authority care
 - 3.3. Have a disability or specific learning difficulty
 - 3.4. Be of black or minority ethnic origin
 - 3.5. Have a permanent home address (not term-time) in a postcode area with low HE progression (students will be asked to provide us with their postcode and we will check this for them)
 - 3.6. Have a permanent home address (not term-time) in an area of higher socio-economic disadvantage (students will be asked to provide us with their postcode and we will check this for them)
4. The student must be a Home fee paying student, entitled to both tuition and maintenance support from Student Finance England
5. Household income is calculated and confirmed by Student Finance England and will be assessed annually
6. Students must be studying on a full time undergraduate degree, paying fees of £9,250
7. The Scholarship will be awarded in one instalments in March 2020.
8. Scholarships will be terminated in cases when students are found to be in breach of the Student Conduct Regulations and have been subject to, and found guilty by, a disciplinary process, which in the judgement of the University would warrant withdrawal of the Scholarship.
9. In circumstances when a student changes programme or mode of study to one which falls outside the eligibility criteria, the student will no longer be eligible for the Scholarship.
10. Students must be in attendance on their Brookes course on the payment dates in order to receive the scholarship.
11. The scholarship is paid in the first year of study only and is not payable in subsequent years.
12. Brookes will pay the Scholarship directly into the bank account for which the student has provided details to Student Finance England.
